

Articulation Agreement
 Between
Schoolcraft College
 and
Oakland County Public School District
Culinary Arts/Hospitality Program

Schoolcraft College and Oakland County Public School District have developed this articulation agreement to facilitate the educational progress of students transferring from Oakland County Public School District to Schoolcraft College’s Professional Culinary Arts program.

Article I

Schoolcraft College and Oakland County Public School District enter into this agreement as cooperating, equal partners who shall maintain the integrity of their separate programs, while working to ensure a smooth transition for students affected by this agreement.

Article II

Schoolcraft College and Oakland County Public School District agree that the *Culinary Arts/Hospitality Program* teach from the National Restaurant Association ProStart, Skills USA or Schoolcraft Culinary Department approved curriculum; and therefore teach equivalent skills to the Schoolcraft College CUL 103 course: Introduction to Professional Cooking Skills and Techniques. The signers to this articulation agree that any student who has successfully completed the *Culinary Arts/Hospitality Program* by earning a **B grade (3.0 or higher)**, and received written recommendation of their high school instructor, may transfer this course as:

Students must matriculate to Schoolcraft college and be admitted to the Schoolcraft College Professional Culinary Arts Program within one year of high school graduation in order to use this agreement.

The Schoolcraft College Professional Culinary Arts Program is a restricted enrollment program which requires demonstration of academic proficiency as well as proof of valid food handling certification. The proficiencies required by the program at the time of the student’s application will be enforced. Currently, those are:

- National Review of Food Safety Professionals: Food Safety Manager or ServSafe: Food Protection Manager certification
- Academic proficiency corresponding to SAT scores of 22 or higher in English, reading and math. Other methods of showing academic proficiency may be discussed with a Schoolcraft College academic advisor.

Article III

This agreement is predicated on the periodic evaluation of the *Culinary Arts/Hospitality Program* curriculum and is subject to modification whenever it is deemed appropriate.

Article IV

Schoolcraft College and Oakland County Public School District agree to communicate annually any curriculum changes or policies which affect the agreed upon relationship. Both parties reserve the right to amend or revise by mutual consent and in writing this agreement or to change curriculum, whenever appropriate.

At least one individual from each institution will be appointed to act as agents for the implementation of this agreement, to speak for the institutions and to communicate changes to respective faculty members, advisors, counselors, and others to

whom the information is pertinent. Responsibility for oversight of this agreement rests with the Director of Advising and Transfer at Schoolcraft College and the administrator at Oakland County Public School District's Culinary Arts/Hospitality program.

Schoolcraft College and Oakland County Public School District will review this agreement every three years and make adjustments or amendments as deemed appropriate to maintain the integrity of each institution's program as well as for improvement of the transfer process and student articulation.

Article V


Either Schoolcraft College or Oakland County Public School District may terminate the agreement by notifying the other party in writing 90 days in advance. Should the agreement be terminated, any student who has designated and selected this articulation prior to termination will be allowed to use the articulation credit to complete their program.

This agreement is effective as of August 1, 2022 until August 1, 2025.

We approve this articulation agreement as described above.


